- J FIC ADL 58 p. ***Cam Jansen and the Mystery of the Monster*** by David Adler  
A fifth-grader uses her photographic memory, her mother, and her friend Eric to find a missing reel of a monster film they go to see.
- J FIC AIK 168 p. ***The Wolves of Willoughby Chase—The Wolves Chronicles, #1*** by Joan Aiken  
Wicked wolves without and a grim governess within threaten Bonnie and her cousin Sylvia when Bonnie's parents leave Willoughby Chase for a sea voyage.
- J FIC AND 188 p. ***Whales on Stilts*** by M.T. Anderson  
Racing against the clock, shy middle-school student Lily and her best friends, Katie and Jasper, must foil the plot of her father's conniving boss to conquer the world using an army of whales.
- J FIC BAI 175 p. ***How Come the Best Clues Are Always in the Garbage?—Stevie Diamond Mystery, #1*** by Linda Bailey  
When a thief steals money from her mom's Garbage Busters project, Stephanie, a sixth grader, sets off to find the culprit.
- J FIC BAL 254 p. ***Chasing Vermeer*** by Blue Balliett  
When a precious Vermeer painting disappears, eleven-year-olds Petra and Calder combine their talents to solve an international art scandal.
- J FIC BUC 284 p. ***The Fairy-tale Detectives—The Sisters Grimm, #1*** by Michael Buckley  
Orphans Sabrina and Daphne Grimm are sent to live with an eccentric grandmother that they have always believed to be dead.

Miss Muller is a language teacher at a Belfast boarding school during WWII. Could Miss Muller be a spy?

While staying with her elderly relative at Winterbloom, Jo tries to solve the mysteries that haunt this strange old house in the midst of New Hampshire woods.
- J FIC CUR 151 p. ***Mr. Chickee's Funny Money*** by Christopher Paul Curtis  
Flint Future Detective Club members Steven Carter, his friend Russell, and Russell's huge dog Zoopy solve the mystery of a quadrillion-dollar bill with the image of James Brown on it.
- J FIC ERI 136 p. ***The Original Adventures of Hank the Cowdog*** by John R. Erickson  
Hank the Cowdog, Head of Ranch Security, is framed for the murder of a chicken and becomes an outlaw with the coyotes.
- J FIC ERN 163 p. ***Trouble at Fort La Pointe—American Girl History Mysteries*** by Kathleen Ernst  
In the early 1700's, twelve-year-old Suzette, an Ojibwa-French girl, must use her knowledge of both French and Ojibwa to find the real thief after her father is accused of stealing.

Bailey City's Hauntly Manor Inn is pretty spooky. Could Dracula, a mad scientist, and Frankenstein's monster be living there?
- J FIC KEE 89 p. ***Sleepover Sleuths—Nancy Drew and the Clue Crew, #1*** by Carolyn Keene  
Nancy Drew investigates when a doll goes missing at a sleepover party.
- J FIC KOR 154 p. ***Chasing the Falconers*** by Gordon Korman  
The Falconers are facing life in prison unless their children, Aidan and Meg, can follow a trail of clues to prove their innocence.
- J FIC LER 139 p. ***Spy X: The Code*** by Peter Lerangis  
Twelve-year-old twins Andrew and Evie's mother disappears, leaving only a cryptic note.
- J FIC NAY 153 p. ***Bernie Magruder and the Disappearing Bodies*** by Phyllis Reynolds Naylor
